## **Our Message To You**

#### **Catholic School Revival**

When we began our renewed journey here at the Foundation nine years ago, we started with a simple promise to each Catholic school family in need that we would accompany them from kindergarten through the eighth grade without fail. At the time, this was a very bold move that carried with it significant financial risks to the Foundation. But we trusted that He knew The Way.

Interestingly, in that first year we focused intently on attracting young families whose first child was entering kindergarten, hoping that the siblings would follow and the family would become part of a Catholic school community. Fast forward nine years. That same student group is now in the eighth grade. And not one of them fell through the cracks!

The year before our renewed journey, we awarded scholarships to 1,480 Catholic elementary students. Last fall, we hit a record 3,700. Indeed, *"The Answer is Yes!"* 

But there's more to the story.... Last fall, for the third consecutive year, our elementary school enrollments rose from the previous year. And as we work through our scholarship awards for this fall and talk with our school teams, it's becoming more apparent that our Catholic school enrollments this fall *will rise yet again* – what fantastic news for the future of this community!!

You see, more and more families are realizing the unmatched value of a Catholic education for their children, and it's showing itself in our numbers. Even now, many of our Catholic elementary schools are at capacity in their pre-kindergarten, kindergarten and first grade classes for next fall, a phenomenon not seen in this community since perhaps the 1990s.

Looking back, thank God we took that financial risk nine years ago with that kindergarten class. Like every year since, we're going to do the exact same thing this fall. And our Catholic school enrollments will continue to rise going forward!

Without doubt, He knows The Way!

#### Salute Dinner Event a Blowout!!

The 34th annual edition of the Salute to Catholic School Alumni dinner event once again rocketed the mission of the Foundation to new heights! Hosting a sold-out ballroom of 1,300 guests on March 5 at downtown Louisville's Galt House Hotel, this "one-of-a-kind Catholic school reunion" continued its tradition as a hallmark community event in the Commonwealth.

This year's event soared to an astonishing **record of \$1.6 million in net proceeds**, blowing past the previous year record of \$1.5 million. Foundation President **Richard A. Lechleiter** remarked, "From our humble beginnings in 1990, this unsurpassed event is now lifting the hopes and dreams of thousands of young Catholic school students and their families through the life-changing gift of a Catholic education. We are truly humbled by this amazing result and thank God for its unprecedented success."

"Thanks entirely to our unrelenting donors, this marks the 15th consecutive year in which this event has posted a new fundraising record. And look at what our donors have done for our Catholic school students and their families! It's the kind of result people only dream about!"

All the funds from the Salute will be used to provide tuition assistance to families who cannot afford the full cost of a Catholic elementary education for their children. Last fall, the Foundation and its partners supported an all-time high 3,700 elementary students throughout the Archdiocese of Louisville's 39 Catholic schools with a record \$8 million in tuition assistance.

Mr. Lechleiter noted that the organization's home-grown slogan - "The Answer is YES!" – has become a mandate to assist every family who reaches out to the Foundation. "In each of the last nine years, every student who reached out to us and qualified for tuition assistance in fact earned an award. **Every single one!** What could be better for our young families and our community!"

**Father Nate Wills** from the Alliance for Catholic Education at the University of Notre Dame served as the keynote speaker for the evening, sharing the inspiring stories of young Alliance graduates and their profound impact on underserved Catholic communities across the nation.

In addition, for the first time in the event's 34-year history, **Ms. Valentina Rocha**, an undergraduate at U of L's Speed School of Engineering whose family was assisted by the Foundation at St. Rita School and Mercy Academy, spoke so eloquently of her Catholic school journey and how the Foundation changed the trajectory of her entire family. There was not a dry eye in the house!

The Salute also was highlighted by its recognition of six distinguished honorees whose success in life was nurtured by their Catholic education. The **Salute Class of 2024** included:


The online raffle can be found on the Foundation's website, <u>ceflou.org</u>, through May 21, with the drawing to be held on Wednesday, May 22, 2024.
